Instructions for TBR-20 Battery Powered Telephone Beep Inserter P/N 44020

The TBR-20 inserts a beep every 15 seconds onto phone conversations on almost any type of phone equipped with a modular handset connection. The beep is heard by all parties on the call, and will be recorded if a recorder is used.

The TBR-20 is battery powered and therefore not dependent on phone power or a plug-in power supply. The battery is a common lithium type that is designed to last 1 year, and is customer replaceable. For phones that have power available at the handset, call about our phone powered TBR-10.

The TBR-20 has a Beep Volume Adjust using a small screwdriver. Installation takes just a few minutes.

INSTALLATION (See Diagram)

1. Unplug the handset coil cord from the phone base, and plug it into the modular jack on the TBR-20.
2. Plug the TBR-20 modular cable into the jack on the phone where the coil cord used to be.
3. Lift off the battery cover as shown.
4. Install a 3 Volt lithium battery, being careful to install the + end as shown in the diagram. DO NOT INSTALL BATTERY BACKWARDS. Acceptable batteries are: Varta CR1/2AA, Eagle Picher LTC-9C, Sanyo CR14250SE or Tadiran TL5902/S.
5. Re-install the battery cover.
6. Adjust the beep volume if necessary with the Beep Volume Adjustment as shown.
7. The TBR-20 may be left as-is on the desk or it may be mounted with the adhesive pad included to a convenient location on the phone or desk.
